Monthly Social Dance with Lessons

Beginning Saturday, January 28, VSCS will be holding a monthly social dance and Victorian dance lesson in Colorado Springs. There will be fun for experienced and new dancers alike. Here's your chance to mix and mingle in a fun setting with other Victorians while learning the finer points of the dance as it was done in 19th century Colorado. Beginners will learn the basics from the ground up, but even experienced dancers will learn something new each month.

After April we will break for the summer and then reconvene in October.

Learn waltzes, reels, marches, polkas, quadrilles, Sicilian circles, and maybe even a Schottische. We will start with the basics and build on what you have learned each month. By April you will be able to step in without trepidation at any Victorian dance in Colorado.

I don't have anything to wear!

Victorian attire is not required. Be casual and comfortable. But do bring clean-soled shoes suitable for dancing. ***We will be dancing on a hardwood floor and street shoes will not be allowed.***

Where is it?

The events take place in Colorado Springs near Garden of the Gods. We will give you directions when you sign up.

Do I need a partner?

Singles are surely welcome, but it's always better if you can bring your own partner as we cannot guarantee an even gender balance or that there will be enough "angels" to go around.

Are children allowed?

Absolutely! Youngsters are always encouraged. Those under 16 must be accompanied by a parent, though, and depending on the child's size and physical maturity, those under 10 may find energetic dancing with full-sized adults to be hazardous.

How much does it cost?

\$5 per person per session to cover the cost of the venue and any class materials.
